



HELP SHAPE CREATIVE RENFREWSHIRE

Creative Renfrewshire is a network which inspires, connects, informs and shines the Spotlight on creative and cultural activities across Renfrewshire.

Creative Renfrewshire has achieved a great deal with limited capacity since its establishment in 2012. As a voluntary run network which has shared best practice and acted as a gateway for information and communication; the core group are now keen to progress Creative Renfrewshire to the next level. The next phase is to constitute as a social enterprise (a Company Limited by Guarantee), a cultural organisation, which has the potential to generate more opportunities for people, communities and the area, with a refreshed outlook, staffing capacity and increased sustainability.

A great deal of work has been undertaken to consider what's next for Creative Renfrewshire, including visiting other creative place networks, in Hull, Dumfries and Dundee; the network has also run workshops and events with the core group and broader creative community to explore What's Next? Feedback gained at these events, considering what people have been proud of in the past, and what they hope to achieve in future, has been very useful in developing a three year Organisational Development Plan (2018-21).

We currently have an exciting opportunity to recruit Independent Directors/Trustees to join the Board of Creative Renfrewshire. We are hoping to find individuals who have an interest in enriching the lives of people who live, work and visit Renfrewshire and can bring with them skills and experience that would help the organisation grow and develop in the future. An interest in the creative sector, culture or heritage would be advantageous but not essential.

The current skills required that we have identified on our board are: –

- Organisational Leadership
- Finance and Governance
- Events Management
- Fundraising / Income Generation
- Legal
- Communication and Marketing
- Strategic Cultural Sector Development
- Digital Innovation

The board will meet every 6 weeks initially at a time to be arranged. Sub-committee meetings and work between meetings will be likely as the new board is established. These board vacancies are key to the future development and ambitions of Creative Renfrewshire and will help deliver on the three year Organisational Development Plan and set the strategic direction of Creative Renfrewshire. In addition to its governing and leadership role, the board has responsibility for the sound management of the organisation and support for the future Operational Team including proposed roles of Community Manager and Digital Producer.
